You have been asked to report on the natural crisis in Country A for an international NGO. In the report, you are to include:

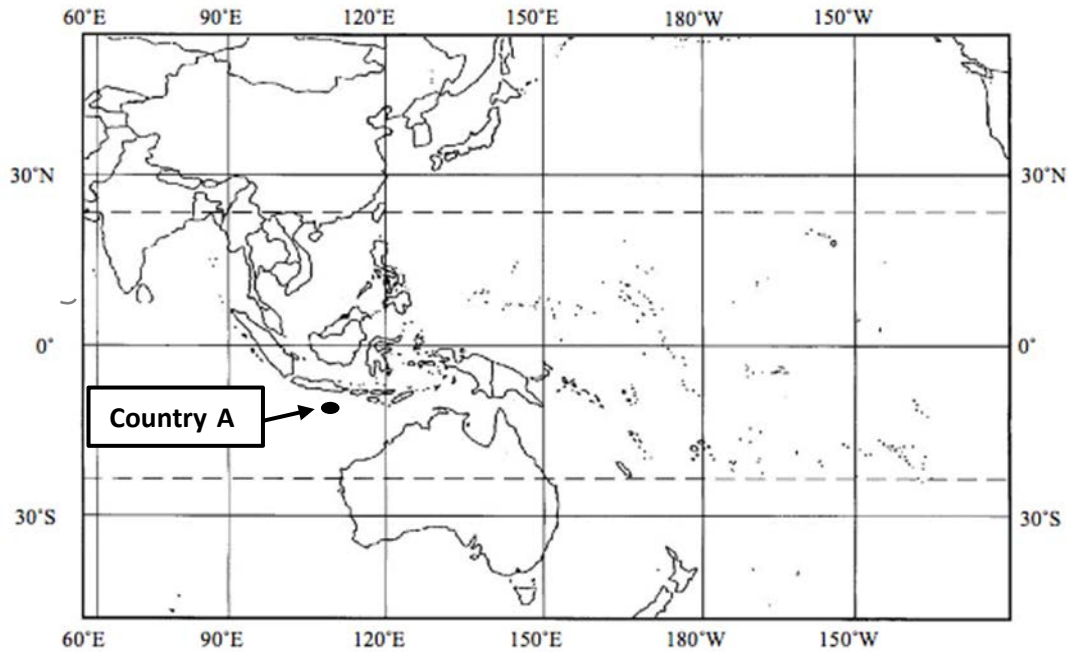
- (a) the immediate and future effects of the crisis in Country A,
